

## "Reform of the Mining Investment Regime"

In order to accelerate project development, streamline procedures, and reduce bureaucratic state involvement, Decree 449/2025 was enacted, introducing significant amendments to the current legal framework. Among the most important changes and benefits are the following:

<b>Art. 26</b> (Law 24.196) – Verification of Commitments	Compliance verification was conducted through field inspections or direct control by the authority.	Verification is done through <b>cross-checking</b> of the annual declaration and technical report submitted under Art. 18.	<ul> <li>Administrative efficiency.</li> <li>Strengthened document-based control without on-site inspections.</li> <li>Reduction of costs and processing times.</li> </ul>
<b>Art. 27</b> (Law 24.196) – Geological Information	Geological surface data were submitted to the database of the Secretariat of Mining.	The data must be submitted to a database <b>managed by SEGEMAR</b> (Argentine Geological Mining Service).	<ul> <li>✓ Avoids overlapping functions.</li> <li>✓ SEGEMAR has greater technical capacity to manage the database.</li> </ul>

<b>Art. 1</b> (Law 24.466) – National Geological Data Bank	The Geological Information Bank was under the direct responsibility of the Secretariat of Mining.	The bank is now <b>under SEGEMAR</b> , an agency within the Ministry of Economy.	<ul> <li>✓ Management is centralized in a technical agency.</li> <li>✓ Improves systematization and access to geological data.</li> <li>✓ Reduces duplication within the state.</li> </ul>

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
