

"Reform of the Mining Investment Regime"

In order to accelerate project development, streamline procedures, and reduce bureaucratic state involvement, Decree 449/2025 was enacted, introducing significant amendments to the current legal framework. Among the most important changes and benefits are the following:

Art. 18 (Law 24.196) – Annual Declaration	Annual declarations of investments and works were submitted without additional validation.	Must include a technical report by an independent professional alongside the annual declaration.	 Enhanced technical oversight without relying on direct inspections. Improves transparency and the quality of information. Reduces the burden of direct government audits.
Art. 26 (Law 24.196) – Verification of Commitments	Compliance verification was conducted through field inspections or direct control by the authority.	Verification is done through cross-checking of the annual declaration and technical report submitted under Art. 18.	 Administrative efficiency. Strengthened document-based control without on-site inspections. Reduction of costs and processing times.
Art. 27 (Law 24.196) – Geological Information	Geological surface data were submitted to the database of the Secretariat of Mining.	The data must be submitted to a database managed by SEGEMAR (Argentine Geological Mining Service).	 ✓ Avoids overlapping functions. ✓ SEGEMAR has greater technical capacity to manage the database.

Art. 1 (Law 24.466) – National Geological Data Bank	The Geological Information Bank was under the direct responsibility of the Secretariat of Mining.	The bank is now under SEGEMAR , an agency within the Ministry of Economy.	 ✓ Management is centralized in a technical agency. ✓ Improves systematization and access to geological data. ✓ Reduces duplication within the state.

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
